- 2. Grace-unmerited favor; did not earn
- 3. Redemption-to let go free for a ransom; to buy back
- 4. Propitiation-to appease; be completely satisfied; removal of wrath
- 5. Righteous-holy, pure
- 6. Sanctification-to be set apart; now that we are set apart we should become mature in Christ.
- 7. Atonement-To Cover; Used primarily in the Old Testament Romans 5:11 should be Reconciliation
