Plum Line

- Amos 7:8 states, "Look, I am setting a plumb line among my people."
- God will measure our beliefs by His standards, His Word, and no other.
- We will use God's Word as a plumb line used in this study to define the differences between the basic truths on which Christianity was founded and what other faiths believe.





 - "The person and work of Christ-who He is and what He did for us."



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
- "Mankind's major problem-all of us are sinners in rebellion against God and in need of a Savior."

- "By definition the backbone of Christianity is Christ. There are two key issues concerning Jesus Christ: who He is and what He did."
 - "Who is He? Only a man? God disguised as a man? Or was He someone uniquely different?"
 - "What did He do? Teach us how to live? Die for our sins?

Question One-Was Jesus really God, or was He a great teacher and nothing more than that?

- John 1:1-Jesus refers to Christ as the Word-"in the beginning (arche-before there was any beginning whatsoever, the word had been) was the Word...and the Word was with God and the Word was God.
- John 1:14-"the Word (God) became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the One and only, full of grace and truth."






Question Three-Does the Trinity make three gods?

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
- Most religions reduce Christ to a created being who is "second-incommand" at best or just another teacher on the same par with Buddha, Krishna or Moses.

- The Great Commission-Matthew 28:19 "baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit."



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
Question Four-Did Christ actually rise from the dead?

- In our culture it has become generally accepted that truth and morals are relative, that there are no objective or absolute truths and morals.
- Without an absolute measuring stick about right and wrong, the ultimate result is moral chaos.
- Romans 1:18-20
 describes a universal
 moral law placed in each
 of us. [*]

- Paul states that through nature and the very world around them, they neither glorified God nor thanked Him and instead plunged into idolatry-serving created things rather than their creator.
 - 1 John 1:8 "if we claim to be without sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us".
 - Many religions do not claim that we are born in sin.



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Question Seven-How could Jesus Christ die for everyone's sins? Isn't every person responsible for his own sins?



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- Many religions and cults admit the problem of sin, but their answer is to seek salvation from sin through good works or by keeping rules and laws.
- The Christian's Bible teaches that Jesus Christ redeemed us from sin by dying on the cross (Rom. 3:23,24). [*]



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- Romans 3:25 states, "God presented Him (Christ) as a sacrifice of atonement, through faith in his blood."
- Since Christ is God, no one less than God could make payment for the sins of everyone.



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 We are saved by grace-"For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith-and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God-not by works, so that no one can boast" (Eph. 2:8,9)



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
 Many people have difficulty accepting the concept that they cannot earn God's favor. Deep down, they believe they can earn salvation by being "good enough."



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

Question Eight-Is the Bible actually "inspired by God"? Why is the Bible supposed to be superior to other books?





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- Historical and scientific
- The Old Testament contains over 300 references to the Messiah that were fulfilled in Jesus Christ. Fulfilling 8 prophecies would be equal to 1017 power, or 1 in 100 quadrillion.

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Question Ten-How was the canon formed?




 In the Early Church, apostolic authorship (or at least close association with a recognized apostle) was one of the chief criteria for deciding what books should be included in the New Testament canon ("group of authoritative books").

John 20:24-29

24 But Thomas, one of the twelve, who was called Didymus, was not with them when Jesus came. 25 So the other disciples were saying to him, "We have seen the Lord!" But he said to them, "Unless I see in His hands the imprint of the nails, and put my finger into the place of the nails, and put my hand into His side, I will not believe."

26 Eight days later His disciples were again inside, and Thomas was with them. Jesus *came, the doors having been shut, and stood in their midst and said, "Peace be to you."

27 Then He *said to Thomas, "Place your finger here, and see My hands; and take your hand and put it into My side; and do not continue in disbelief, but be a believer." 28 Thomas answered and said to Him, "My Lord and my God!" [Theos-name of the true God] 29 Jesus *said to him, "Because you have seen Me, have you now believed? Blessed are they who did not see, and yet believed." [*]

Romans 5:17-21

17 For if by the offense of the one, death reigned through the one, much more will those who receive the abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ.

18 So then, as through one offense the result was condemnation to all mankind, so also through one act of righteousness the result was justification of life to all mankind.

Over---

19 For as through the one man's disobedience the many were made sinners, so also through the obedience of the One the many will be made righteous. 20 The Law came in so that the offense would increase; but where sin increased, grace abounded all the more, 21 so that, as sin reigned in death, so also grace would reign through righteousness to eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord. [*]

Romans 3:23-24

23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, 24being justified as a gift by His grace through the redemption which is in Christ Jesus... [1]

Romans 1:18-20

18 For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of people who suppress the truth in unrighteousness, 19 because that which is known about God is evident within them; for God made it evident to them. 20 For since the creation of the world His invisible attributes, that is, His eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly perceived, being understood by what has been made, so that they are without excuse.
